



## School Accountability Meeting Minutes November 12, 2019

### Student Comments: Mo Jensen, Student Council President

- PA system working to improve communication.
- Flags in our rooms. Draws out extra respect from our students.
- Increase in student safety and security with the double door and the one exit fence outside.
- More school events to meet new people. Like a pep rally.
- Student-teacher night to get to know their teachers (back-to-school event?)
- More club opportunities: cross cultural sharing, cross-religious sharing, DECA, FBLA, FFA, TSA, etc. Helps build leadership opportunities and public speaking opportunities

### Thoughts on student involvement:

- Stream weekly announcements over Teams into classrooms
- Disseminate CEC policies on how to create clubs via Mo and other student club leaders
- Remind101 for notifying students and updating them. Push texts to students.

### Celebrations:

- A. John Irwin Award School of Excellence: won for the 4th year in a row
  - B. SPF, School Performance Framework: Performance--low participation (explained that it was about the difference between participation with opt outs-- 90% and without opt outs-- 100%)
  - C. CARS Report-- second to highest in points in the district
- Performing at high levels on SAT in Math and English. There is a lack of growth in PSAT Math 53 Median Growth Percentage.

### Expansion:

- A. Steering Committee: Org. Chart and hiring
  - Concern about watering down what we do well in staffing 2 campuses
  - Frontline program for blasting out positions
- B. Enrollment: Parker- 490 students
  - Castle rock- 60 students, (20 students from Parker) shooting for 350
  - Inverness- 16 students, (3 students from Parker) shooting for 350
  - Demolition for Inverness will start over winter break. 90,000 sq. ft.

### Safety:

- Alarmed fence completed
- Window check-in with Raptor: scan IDs
- Campus Monitor
- Mental Health team: referral form
- Restorative justice for discipline using a peer "teen court." Focused on learning opportunities rather than suspension.
- Safe-to-Tell
- Radios and new cameras
- Intercom system--problems with initial wiring (60% throughout building). Winter break upgrades
- Drills and reunification plans at Field House
- How do we track students who are not supposed to be off-campus and monitor that?
