Colorado Early College Douglas County North Traffic Management Plan For the 2024-2025 School Year

Colorado Early Colleges Douglas County North (CECDCN) is committed to student safety, efficient onsite traffic management and modeling "good neighbor" behavior to our Douglas County community surrounding our High School at 321 Inverness Drive South.

CECDCN will manage all traffic flow on site by directing traffic with trained CECDCN staff members who will communicate via radios and are easily recognizable in high visability safety vests.

A diagram of the Traffic Management Plan (TMP) indicating directional traffic flow, drop-off and pick-up zones is located below.

The CECDCN property is to be used for all pick-up and drop-off of students for the school year, school events and on-site parking. CECDCN's TMP has been developed and will be monitored by a traffic management team that includes the CECDCN Executive Director, the CECDCN Head of School, the CEC Director of Safety and Security, CEC's traffic engineer consultant as well as a dedicated number of CEC staff who will be trained to execute the CEC TMP.

CEC Douglas County North Start and Release Schedule

- Student drop-off is 7:15 am to 7:50 am
- First period starts at 7:45 am
- Last period ends at 3:20 pm
- Student pick-up is from 3:20 pm to 3:50 pm

Parent/Student Vehicular Traffic Flow

- All traffic will enter the site from Inverness Drive East. The drive from Inverness Way South will be blocked with traffic cones.
- All drivers will be directed through the site where ample stacking of vehicles is facilitated. Parents
 will be allowed to park, if desired, but the only viable path to exit the site will be to follow the traffic
 flow of the TMP. Vehicle paths not conforming with the TMP will be blocked with cones and
 monitored by the on-site TMP team.
- Student drop-off is facilitated with a wide sidewalk directly in front of the school where students are off-loaded or picked-up. Vehicles that are ready to leave can pull into the adjacent one-way travel lane and proceed directly east to exit the site onto Inverness Drive East.
- Right entry into the site and right turn exit from the site will be encouraged.

CECDCN Bus Traffic Flow

- CEC buses enter from a separate dedicated drive north of the parent site entry, also off Inverness Drive East.
- Buses will pick up/drop-off students adjacent to the north side of the school.
- Buses will travel on the perimeter of the faculty parking lot to exit the site using the same dedicated drive north of the parent site entry, also off Inverness Drive East. (Buses enter and exit the site from the same point). Buses arrive on site prior to the start of parent drop-off and pickup.

- A clear sidewalk will lead all students to the main front entry.
- The circular drive in front of the main entry will be closed to vehicular traffic during drop-off or pick up and dedicated to student pedestrian traffic.

Site Parking

- The CECDCN site parking spaces meet all accessibility guidelines. Parking is designated for visitors, faculty/staff, and CEC families and students.
- Visitors and volunteers will park in faculty or designated parking spaces.
- Disabled parking and drop-off will be accessible at all times. If a disabled person arrives on site or
 wishes to depart the site during drop-off or pick-up, they will be guided to/from the front entry and
 dedicated parking spaces by the CEC traffic management staff in yellow safety vests.
- CEC students must have a parking permit and is must be displayed.

CECCN will enforce driveline and parking rules of the Traffic Management Plan through clear communication with families utilizing graphic map diagrams and a clear outline of the TMP expectations. No drop off permitted on the streets surrounding DC North.
