Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone, & Tuba 1. valve oil (EVERY STUDENT NEEDS THEIR OWN.) 2. soft polishing cloth 3. mouthpiece brush 4. cleaning snake 5. your instrument

Trombone 1. Slide-O-Mix slide lubricant (EVERY STUDENT NEEDS THEIR OWN.) 2. soft polishing cloth 3. mouthpiece brush 4. cleaning snake 5. your instrument

Percussion 1. SD1 General snare drum sticks 2. practice pad
