Flute 1. soft polishing cloth 2. tuning rod 3. your instrument

Clarinet, Saxophones, Oboe, & Bassoon 1. minimum of four reeds for clarinet and saxophone students: minimum of two reeds for oboe and bassoon 2. reed guard 3. swab 4. mouthpiece brush (clarinet and saxophone only) 5. small pill bottle filled with water to soak reeds (oboe and bassoon only) 6. your instrument

Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone, & Tuba 1. valve oil (EVERY STUDENT NEEDS THEIR OWN.) 2. soft polishing cloth 3. mouthpiece brush 4. cleaning snake 5. your instrument

Trombone 1. Slide-O-Mix slide lubricant (EVERY STUDENT NEEDS THEIR OWN.) 2. soft polishing cloth 3. mouthpiece brush 4. cleaning snake 5. your instrument

Percussion 1. SD1 General snare drum sticks 2. practice pad
