



Nonmedical Exemption Form

The new nonmedical exemption form requires either a signature from an immunizing provider or time and date stamp after completion of an online module. Here is a summary of the information provided on [Colorado's CDPHE webpage](#) about nonmedical vaccine exemptions:

Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, the process of filing a nonmedical exemption will change. There will be **two** ways to file a nonmedical exemption.

- [File the certificate of nonmedical exemption WITH a signature from an immunizing provider](#), OR
- File the certificate of nonmedical exemption received upon the completion of the online education module.
 - [Online Immunization Education Module](#)
 - The online education module is available 24 hours a day and seven days a week. It will take approximately 20 minutes to complete.
 - At the completion of the module, you will be able to complete a form to obtain a certificate of nonmedical exemption. You can complete this form for more than one child without having to retake the course.
