1. Discussed "Glows and Grows" of the 2020-21 school year
 - a. "Glows"
 - i. Availability of teachers to students and parents

 - i. More communication with teachers and parents. Mrs. Lewis suggested a newsletter from each teacher with overviews of units that will be taught each quarter/month. This would give parents the opportunity to reinforce at home what is being taught at school.
 - ii. Mr. Lewis asked about the extent of politics/government content in the curriculum. Ms. Smith explained that Civics is taught in 9th grade. In general, teachers address political issues as they come up without going in depth with their own opinions.
 - iii. Ms. Smith touched on DEI (Diversity, Equity and Inclusion) programs and the need for more information before "jumping on the bandwagon." Students are encouraged to speak with Mrs. Lockman if they have concerns. Mrs. Lewis expressed the opinion that racial and gender discussion should be at home and not at school.
 - iv. SAC Committee growth is a goal for the Fall 2021-22 school year. Parent participation greatly affected by COVID-19. Many parents have expressed the desire to participate next year.
 - v. Ms. Smith will work with marketing team to get minutes and agendas of SAC meetings on the school website.
