JFB-O Enrollment After Count Day

Colorado Early Colleges are schools that have been authorized by the Charter School Institute as a charter school in the state of Colorado. Per state statute, all public schools are funded for the students who attend the school based upon their enrollment as of October 1, or count day. Due to funding constraints, the following policy is hereby adopted by the governing board of Colorado Early Colleges.

CEC POLICY REGARDING ENROLLING STUDENTS AFTER COUNT DAY

CEC will not enroll new students after count day. The only exceptions will be as follows:

1. If the governing board of CEC opens the enrollment for the following year early and conducts a lottery for those students who would commit to attend the following year.
2. If the governing board of CEC authorizes the Administrator or Academic Dean to accept a student for a compelling reason, (i.e. family consideration, sibling preference, academic need).
3. Any other situation deemed necessary by a vote of the board.
4. If on a limit basis, a decision is made by the Administrator in conjunction with the Head of School of the specific charter school the need to allow enrollment of students after the October 1, count day.
