- a. Presented scores from spring testing
 - i. Highlights
 1. Middle school ELA increased by almost 20%, minority students grew substantially
 2. Middle school math meets expectations
 3. Middle school jumped 30% and exceeded expectations
 - a. Area of focus identified for improvement: academic growth
 - i. Free/reduced lunch students need most focus in ELA
 - b. Area of focus: math growth
 4. High School
 - a. Meet expectations in ELA and math
 - b. Growth focus on minority students
 - c. Outperforming D11 over time
 5. Post-secondary
 - a. Drop-out rate in multi-language learners do not meet expectations but that is equivalent to 1.2 students because we don't know what happened to them after they left our school
 - b. Data for matriculation to 2 year and 4 year is skewed because:
 - i. 146 graduates in 2024-earned 76+ degrees
- b. School Performance Framework (SPF)
 - i. Reported to CSI annual support of schools (CARS report achievement over time compared to D11)
 1. Middle school students achieved higher than D11 for most data over time
 - ii. Then reported to the board
- c. Discussed UIP Improvement strategies:
 - i. ELA curriculum improvement
 - ii. Math intervention systems on Fridays
 - iii. Math curriculum "Big Ideas"
 - iv. Established interdepartmental communication systems
